

PARTICIPATORY ACTION RESEARCH MODEL

OER Africa has identified participatory action research as the most appropriate to approach to achieve the outlined grant purposes. As indicated by the diagram below, we envisage an iterative action research process, enabling organizational change, and leading to key identifiable actions and outputs that are conceived, acted upon, reviewed and revised through ongoing discussion and debate with the relevant stakeholders. It is further intended that the lessons of experience that emanate from these processes should be shared more widely through appropriately open forums. In this regard, our advocacy will seek to both stimulate further engagement with OER as a pillar of pedagogic transformation and the implementation of processes and policies that seek to ensure that such transformation becomes a reality.
